Hi Melanie.

- 1. In the letter attached to the wire Serrano is requesting reimbursement in the amount of \$1,691,950.20. The wire from CDS is for \$1,691,735.43 (\$214.77 less than requested).
 - The difference between the amount requested for the wire transfer and the amount requested by Serrano (\$214.77), was due to some of Serrano's calculations using a rounded percentage of 88% instead of 87.78%. We communicated with Serrano regarding this error and they agreed to the change.
- 2. On the summary of cost sheet the split between private and public allocation is identified as 12.22% and 87.78%. The split is calculated using these percentages for engineering and plan check & inspections but not for landscape construction (10.68% and 89.32%). In addition, some costs in the Engineering section have zero private allocation (immaterial amounts). Please review and advise if this is accurate.
 - The overall percentages were skewed slightly because some costs were determined to be fully reimbursable to Serrano, specifically costs incurred due to the bidding process mandated by the county. These alterations were also discussed with Serrano and approved by DOT and Community Development. The deviations from the percentages listed above was not an

As required by the County of El Dorado Guidelines for Special Districts Acquisition Projects and as authorized by the Acquisition Funding and Disclosure Agreement between the El Dorado Hills Development Company (now Serrano Associates, LLC) and the County of El Dorado, dated September 22, 1992, we are submitting this request for reimbursement of eligible project costs from District funds.

The work included in this reimbursement request relates to landscaping of the above referenced roads. It includes engineering, landscape architecture, plan checking, inspections and landscape construction.

The total amount requested for reimbursement for the subject work is \$1,691,950.20. This reimbursement should be taken from County funds allocated CFD No. 1992-1.

The breakdown of original contract amounts, change orders and costs eligible for reimbursement for both projects are included in the Construction Data and Reimbursable Costs Book #37 (two volumes). Volume #1 contains detailed costs breakdowns, actual installed quantities and engineering back-up, as well as other required items. Volume #2 contains details of all overhead costs, engineering, landscape design and construction, supervision and inspection as well as copies of all invoices paid. A summary of costs is contained in Attachment 2 to this letter.

Serrano Associates, LLC certifies to the District Engineer and the County of El Dorado that with reference to the subject work of this reimbursement request, that prevailing wages have been paid for all contractors and subcontractors, and all other labor code requirements for public works have been complied with, and the facilities were completed pursuant to the Guidelines and requirements of Section 53314.9 of the Mello-Roos Act. All warranties, guarantees or other evidence of contingent obligations of the third parties with respect to such facilities shall be delivered to the CAO prior to acceptance.

To the best of Serrano Associates' knowledge, no mechanics liens exist against the property on which the work was performed and title of which rests with the El Dorado Irrigation District or El Dorado County.

In accordance with Section 12 of the above-mentioned Acquisition Funding and Disclosure Agreement, Serrano Associates has provided written notification to each and every purchaser of residential homes or commercial property owner upon which a Special Tax will be levied as a result of work performed under this project.

Please see attachments for pertinent correspondence and documentation.

Please note, per our previous conversation, that we would like for this review to proceed while we address one outstanding issue. As required by the El Dorado Hills Specific Plan and Public Improvements Financing Plan, the Serrano Master Owner's Association is responsible for maintenance of the landscape corridor. However as a backup financing mechanism, the El Dorado Hills CSD may assume maintenance of the improvements if the Association abandons or fails to maintain to certain standards via a Landscape and Lighting District and Grant of Easement Agreement. Discussions with the CSD concerning the LLAD and Grant of Easement have been initiated but remain uncompleted at this time. See Section C8 of Volume #2, the Construction Data Book, for the current status of this document. When the Grant of Easement Agreement is completed and recorded, we will forward a copy to you. We believe we have satisfied all other requirements for receiving reimbursement for our costs associated with this work and acknowledge that you cannot release reimbursement until we provide you with a copy of the recorded Grant of Easement.

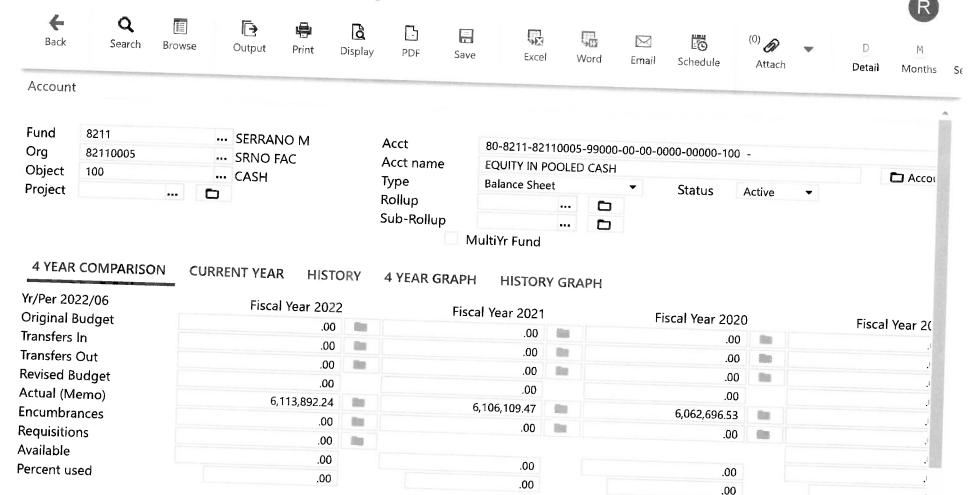
