RE: **All Bidders Letter for Radio Simulcast Services and Installation, BID #2025-0133**

We thank you for your interest and for bidding on the Radio Simulcast Services and Installation project. As you are aware, the bid opening took place on Friday, December 12, 2025. After careful review of the two (2) submitted proposals, the following has been determined:

1.) Find the low Bidder's, **Alpha Omega Wireless, Inc.**, proposal non-responsive due to the following reasons:

- The Bidder's Bond was not signed by the Bidder.
- The Bidder didn't include the OSHA approved Tower Climbers Certification required by the bid documents.
- Addendum I and Addendum II were not noted on the signature page of the Bidder's Proposal.

2.) Find the 2nd low Bidder's, **SLC, Inc.**, proposal non-responsive due to the following reason:

- The Bidder doesn't possess the required C-7 – Low Voltage Systems or Class C10 – Electrical contractor licenses required by the bid documents.

Should a Bidder wish to protest the bid, the Bid Protest Procedures are listed in the Instructions to Bidders, Page I-3, Section 17. Bid protests must be received for consideration by the County's Procurement & Contracts Division in accordance with Section 17 of the Instructions to Bidders. The Bidder protesting the above findings must submit a letter of protest to the attention of Michele Weimer at the County's Procurement & Contracts Division, 330 Fair Lane, Placerville, California 95667, and state in detail the basis and reasons for the protest. The Bidder must provide facts to support the protest, including any evidence they wish considered, together with the law, rule, or criteria on which the protest is based.

The recommendations listed above are subject to change should the Procurement & Contracts Division receive a request for reconsideration or a bid protest.

Pursuant to the provisions of El Dorado County Ordinance code §3.14.080 and California Public Contract Code §22038, the Sheriff's Office intends to re-bid the project this year. All prospective bidders will be notified when the project is being re-advertised for bid.
