2.	SP-68	<b>Question:</b> Please confirm that the work associated with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) will be done using the Method process. <b>Answer:</b> Attention is directed to the first sentence of Section 10-1.20 "Hot Mix Asphalt" of the Special Provisions.
3.	SP-46	Question: Is the County requiring the use of the scheduling software specified on SP-46?  Answer: Yes
4.	N-4	Question: Is the addenda posted on the DOT website a pdf document explaining the items or just a notice the addenda has been issued?  Answer: A pdf of the addendum itself will be posted on the DOT website in accordance with the PROJECT ADMINISTRATION paragraph in the Notice to Bidders.
5.	N/A	Question: Would the County consider posting a pdf of the plans and specifications on the DOT website for use by the bidders in electronically transmitting information to the bidder's subcontractors and suppliers?  Answer: For this project DOT has transmitted the plans and specifications in pdf format to the builders' exchanges and trade journals either directly or through onlineplanservice.com. P-5	<b>Question:</b> If the bidder chooses to submit the percentages associated with its Subcontractor Listing on the first business day after the bid opening rather than submitting the percentages with its bid, is the bidder required to use the Subcontractor Listing Form for the percentages? Must the bidder include the bid item description in addition to the bid item number?
		Answer: Attention is directed to Addendum No.1. The Subcontractor Listing Form need not be used for submitting the information that defines the percentage of each bid item subcontracted as long as all of the specified information is included in the submittal. The bid item description and bid item number must both be included in the bidder's Subcontractor Listing Form.
