

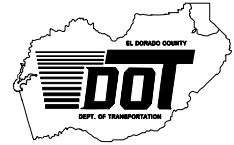

4.01	N-1	<p>Question: Can the bid opening be postponed?</p> <p>Answer: No – funding deadlines will not permit an extension to the bid period.</p>
4.02	IB-2	<p>Question: During the site visit 3D asked if and alternate to the specified Audio Impact Sensor (AIS) would be acceptable. There are many companies that make these AIS devices; one that we have used in the past is Louroe Electronics (http://louroe.com/home.htm). Louroe gives us several options including the ASK-4 KIT #300 Audio Monitoring Kit (http://louroe.com/datasheets/ask4kit_300.pdf) or if you would like the added capability to listen and talk back, the bi-direction speakerphone (http://louroe.com/datasheets/aopsp_cf_cs.pdf) could be used.</p> <p>Please let us know if an alternate device would be allowable.</p> <p>Answer: No. See Item 16 on IB-2. The Public Contract Code does not allow the County to issue within 72 hours of the bid opening addenda containing material changes. The County received your email request today. Since this request was not received in time for the County to review and issue an addendum if the alternate device was determined to be an equal, the provisions of item 16 on page IB-2 govern.</p>
