3.1.	Addendum No. 2 section 14-11.11	<p><b>Question:</b> We just received Addendum #2, concerning the contaminated soil. Since the project bids today, we do not have enough time to digest this information and provide a price that covers it. We are not in the contaminated soil business on a regular basis and need to find Subcontractors who are set up to accomplish this work. Items that are unquantifiable at this time are dewatering quantity and handling procedures, shoring, excavation yardage, fees, permits and training programs.</p> <p>Can we remove this item of work from the project for bidding purposes?</p> <p><b>Answer:</b> No. Section 14-11.11 was revised in Addendum No. 2 to respond to a bidder's questions. (See response to Bidders' Inquiries No 2 Item 2.2.) All of the items mentioned in your email and listed above were in section 14-11.11 as part of the original bid package. Addendum No. 2 was posted at 10:00 a.m. on October 11, 2013. All bids must be based on and submitted in accordance with the plans, specifications, and addenda.</p>
