ITEM NO.	QUESTION/ANSWER
6.01	Question: Note 1 on sheet X-1 (3 of 15), in reference to "final lift" of HMA on new section, this is the only lift other than the overlay, correct? There is a .20ft AC section and a .20ft overlay. I would think the paving section would be placed to match bottom of overlay first and separately, then there would be the .20ft overlay on the entire roadway. Answer: You are correct.
6.02	Question: Note 11 on L-1 states roadway embankment is 1230 cy. The roadway excavation item #25 quantity is 3,550 cy. Can you reconcile this since there is no roadway embankment item? How is the embankment figured into this item? Is there a theoretical quantity of 3,550 cy exc and 1230 cy fill in the same item with a potential export item to be included? Can excavation material be used onsite for embankment? Answer: Item #25, 3350 CY, is the roadway excavation quantity described in Section 19-2.08 of the Standard Specifications and is a final pay quantity in accordance Section 9-1.105 of the Standard Specifications. The 1230 CY roadway embankment is for information only. No export bid item will be added. The excavated material can be used for embankment on site, as long as the excavated material meets the specification for embankment. Disposal of surplus excavated material shall be in accordance with Section 19-2.06 "Surplus Material" of the Standard Specifications.
6.03	Question: Can new asphalt on the south side phase one be utilized for temporary roadway on phase two work. Answer: Yes
