The following is a summary of the non-mandatory pre-bid meeting held on Wednesday, May 29, 2013.

2.01		Question: Is it possible to get a pdf of the plans so we can have full-size sets printed? Answer: Yes. The plans will be posted on our website at http://www.edcgov.us/Government/DOT/Bids.aspx .
2.02	Sheets 5, and 9 through 15 of the 66107 Plans	Question: Is the future sidewalk shown on the 66107 plans part of the work in this contract? Answer: See Note 2 on plan sheet 5 of 66107 Plans and see the shading shown on the layout sheets that indicates what sidewalk is future and what is constructed as part of this contract.
2.03		Question: When do you expect to have a contract in place? Answer: Award is anticipated to be July 16, 2013 and we anticipate there will be a fully-executed contract in mid-August 2013.
2.04		Question: Is there any plan to postpone the bid opening date? Answer: No.
2.05		Question: Will the County provide survey staking and materials testing? Answer: Yes

2.06		Question: When is the latest the County will respond to questions? Answer: Friday, June 14, 2013, 5:00 p.m.
2.07		Question: Will there be a consultant included in the construction management team? Answer: We don't know yet. It depends upon what other projects are going to be constructed this season.
2.08	N-2 and SP-43	Question: Are the cross sections going to be provided? Answer: The cross sections and the Geotechnical Report are posted on our website.
2.09	SP-1 and SP 234	Question: Are EID specifications included for the water and sewer work? Answer: Pages SP-1 and SP-234 refer the Contractor to the EID website at which EID's technical specifications can be found (See Addendum No. 1). The Contract Documents include payment clauses for the sewer and water work.
2.10		Question: Will the sign-in sheet for this meeting be posted on your website? Answer: Yes.
2.11	SP-173	Question: Does the County intend to extend the week-days hours shown in the lane closure chart? Answer: See future Response to Bidders' Inquiries and/or Addendum.
2.12	Staging Plans	Question: Do we have to follow the staging shown on the Plans? Answer: See future Response to Bidders' Inquiries and/or Addendum.
2.13		Although the County encourages participation by Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE), there is no DBE goal or Good Faith Effort submittal requirements on this Contract.
