1.	Special Provisions §4-1.01 (page SP-11); §10-1.00, Item 52 (page SP-73)	Question: Will the County count contract working days after the October 15 th grading deadline? Answer: If grading extensions are granted by the regulatory agencies, the contract work will continue until the expiration of the grading extensions or as weather permits.
2.	Special Provisions §10-1.00, Item 16 (page SP-59)	Question: Will the stumps have to be removed when trees are shown to be removed? Answer: Please refer to the Tree Removal item description on page SP-59 of the Special Provisions.
3.	Special Provisions §10-1.00, Items 36, 37, and 38 (pages SP-67 and SP-68)	Comment: Item 36 notes that the chain link fence shall conform to the provisions of Section 80, "Fences," of the Standard Specifications which states that the chain link fabric for slatted fence must have 3-1/4-inch vertical and 5-1/4-inch horizontal mesh. If fabric is to be 2-inches, then slats will have to be inserted manually and very labor intensive. Please clarify. Response: Please ensure you are using the correct reference and using the 2006 Caltrans Standard Specifications as specified in various locations of the Contract Documents and the Plans. Question: Item 36 notes slats shall be top locking, inserted vertically and shall have NO staples. Top locking does not exist, how do you intend to have the contractor meet this

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		Answer: Contractor has the option to install slats that are also self-locking to comply with this item of work. This option also applies to Items 37 and 38.
4.	Special Provisions §10-1.00, Item 39 (page SP-69)	Comment: Item 39 notes joints are bolted together; supplier suggests a welded connection for a safer railing.
	, ,	Response: The Contractor has the option to choose whatever means necessary to comply with the item/work requirements of the Metal Rail Fence.
