# Sources & Uses of Funds

This budget is made up of \$5,000 in fines and penalties revenue and \$20,000 in program savings from the special revenue fund for the Fish and Wildlife Commission. During FY 2021-22, it is anticipated that up to \$25,000 will be spent on special projects and expenses related to the conservation of fish and wildlife. It is recommended that \$0 be appropriated for contingency for FY 2021-22.
