

SKATE PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS

- The Park is open from dawn to dusk. The County may close the park if determined necessary.
- All persons entering, using, or remaining in the park must wear a shirt and applicable safety equipment.
- Do not bring structures, obstacles, or other materials, such as ramps or jumps, into the park.
- No smoking, tobacco, drugs, and alcoholic beverages.
- No graffiti, tagging, or other defacing park property or the property of others.
- Except for authorized guide dogs and service animals, animals are prohibited.
- No Glass containers.
- Recklessness, horseplay, foul language, vandalism, littering and disrespect to park property and/or other park users is prohibited.
- Do not skate or bicycle on curbs, fences, railings, walls, benches, or tables. Be considerate of nearby businesses and residents.
- No skating or bicycling when the park surfaces are wet.
- All injuries, whether major or minor, suffered at the park are to be reported to County.
- The County is not responsible for lost or stolen belongings.
- Amplified music and sound systems are prohibited without prior written authorization.
- No climbing on or over the park fence.
- No motorized vehicles, including remote control cars and electric bicycles.
- No barbecues or open flames.
- No digging, changing trails, or riding off trail.
- Skateboarding and bicycling has been deemed a hazardous recreational activity by the State of California pursuant to California Government Code section 831.7. Individuals using a skate or bike park owned or operated by the County shall assume all risk of injury or loss.
