



EL DORADO TRAIL BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN OVERCROSSING FACT SHEET

Project Overview

The El Dorado Trail Bicycle and Pedestrian Overcrossing on Missouri Flat Road will construct a bicycle and pedestrian overcrossing as part of the El Dorado Trail to connect the existing El Dorado Trail east of Missouri Flat Road with the trail segment west of Missouri Flat Road. The overcrossing will be constructed of a prefabricated steel truss, rust colored finish, and a 12-foot wide concrete deck.

Status

The project received funding for planning, design, and right of way in July 2014 and construction funding in 2023 and 2024. The project received state and federal environmental clearance, and the design was completed in 2021. As suggested in public comments, the design includes aesthetic features representing the local history and rural character. The project construction is currently being funded by Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Program (CMAQ), Active Transportation Program (ATP), Transportation Development Act (TDA), Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP), and Tribe Funds.

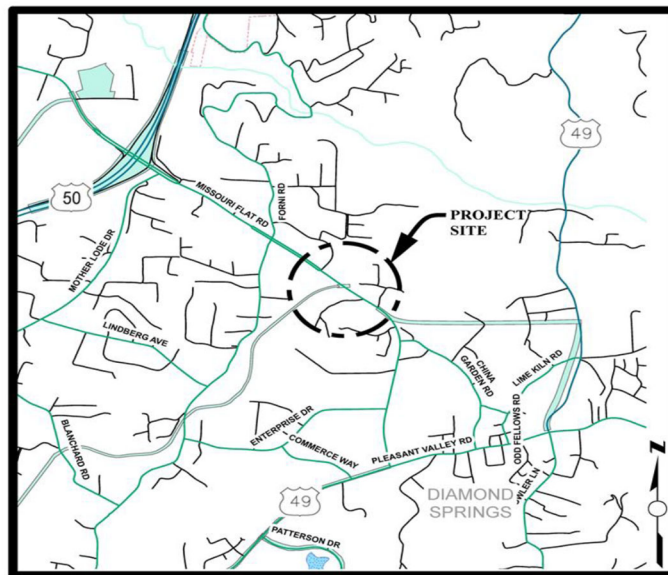
Purpose and Need

This project is included in the El Dorado County Bicycle Transportation Plan and will provide connection of active commercial and business areas; increasing non-motorized access to jobs, services and schools; and, improve safety for the traveling public.

Total Cost: \$7,857,621

Anticipated Construction Start: August 2024 and Completion: June 2025
