



EL DORADO TRAIL BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN OVERCROSSING FACT SHEET

Project Overview

The El Dorado Trail Bicycle and Pedestrian Overcrossing on Missouri Flat Road will construct a bicycle and pedestrian overcrossing as part of the El Dorado Trail to connect the existing El Dorado Trail east of Missouri Flat Road with the trail segment west of Missouri Flat Road. The overcrossing will be constructed of a prefabricated steel truss, rust colored finish, and a 12-foot wide concrete deck.

Status

The project received funding for planning, design, and right of way in July 2014. The most recent public workshop was held in July 2019. The project has received state and federal environmental clearance, and the design is nearly 90% complete. As suggested in public comments, the design includes aesthetic features representing the local history and rural character.

Purpose and Need

This project is included in the El Dorado County Bicycle Transportation Plan and will provide connection of active commercial and business areas; increasing non-motorized access to jobs, services and schools; and, improve safety for the traveling public.

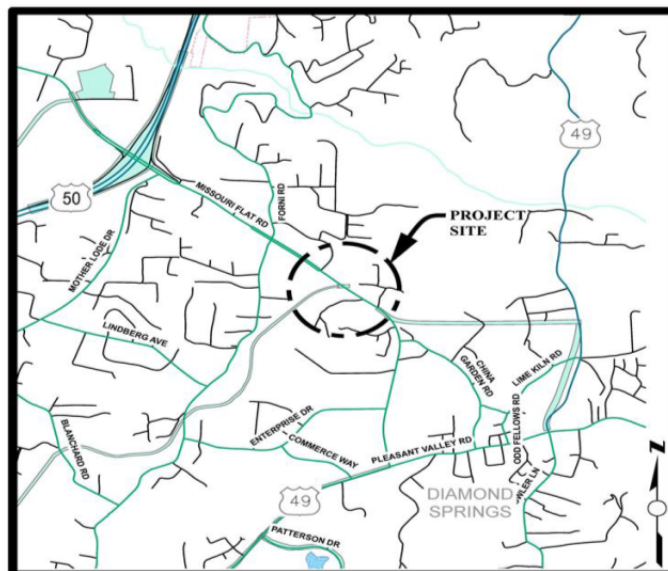
Total Project Cost & Anticipated Completion

Total Cost: \$5,193,000

Anticipated Completion: October 2023

The project is currently being funded by Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Program (CMAQ) funds, with Transportation seeking additional funding through various grant programs.
