El Dorado County to Perform Crane Off-Haul from Mosquito Road Bridge Replacement Project - Traffic Impact Schedule

January 23, 2026

(PLACERVILLE, CA) – This is a courtesy notice to the community that El Dorado County's Department of Transportation (DOT) will be hauling a total of 17 flatbed loads of the 275-ton lattice boom crane from the south staging yard at 7876 Mosquito Road to Highway 50. **No road closures will be required. All loads will have a lead pilot vehicle. Expect traffic to slow down during the scheduled times as shown in the table below and summarized in the attached anticipated schedule.**

The traffic impacts are needed to off-haul the south 275-ton crane off the Mosquito Bridge Project. Truckloads hauling up Mosquito Road to Highway 50 will be slower than typical traffic speeds. The only flagging anticipated to occur will be at various switchbacks on Mosquito Road for the last 5-axle trailer load on January 29, 2026, between 9:00 am and 12:00 pm. The 5-axle load will stage in the pullout at 2821 Jacquier Road for transfer to a 7-axle trailer for legal highway loading. Mosquito Road will remain open to traffic at all times during the crane off-haul. **Drivers should plan to allow for additional travel times and expect delays.**

The County sincerely appreciates the cooperation and patience of motorists who use this roadway, and we apologize for any inconvenience these closures cause.
