

DOG PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Dogs are not permitted except during established hours of operation. Hours of operation shall be from dawn to dusk.
- Dogs are not permitted when the dog park is closed as posted for maintenance, due to weather conditions, or special events.
- Dogs are not permitted without their owners and may not be left unattended. Owners must remain with their dogs at all times and keep their dogs under reasonable control as necessary to ensure safety of others and prevent destruction of property. Dogs must be placed on a leash while entering and exiting the dog park.
- Children under the age of six (6) years old are not permitted. Children must be accompanied and supervised closely by an adult and remain within arm's reach at all times.
- Dogs under the age of four (4) months are not permitted.
- Dogs that are sick or injured are not permitted. Female dogs in heat are not allowed.
- All dogs must be neutered and spayed.
- Each owner is limited to no more than three (3) dogs.
- Dogs exhibiting unruly, aggressive, or other behavior that jeopardizes human or animal safety are not permitted and must be removed.
- Any dog(s) which has been declared vicious or potentially dangerous, pursuant to Chapter 6.12.050 of the County Code is not permitted.
- If a dog injures a person or another dog, owners must exchange contact information, such as name, address, and any insurance information, and a report led with the County Parks Division within five (5) days of the incident.
- Dogs are allowed only in the area designated for their weight class. Large dogs are 30 pounds or over, and small dogs are under 30 pounds.
- Owners shall immediately clean up after their dog(s) and properly dispose of waste in the appropriate waste receptacles.
- The dog park is for use by dogs only. All other activities are prohibited. No animals aside from dogs are permitted.
- Owners must prevent or stop their dog(s) from digging and fill any holes.
- No person shall harass, tease, or incite any dog in any way, including, but not limited to, verbal or physical gestures or throwing of objects other than toss toys.
- Smoking, including the use of electronic cigarette products, and alcohol are prohibited.
- No food, treats, or beverages (except water) for dog or human consumption are allowed.
- No glass containers.
- No toys (except toss toys, such as balls and frisbees) are allowed.

- All dogs must be collared, licensed, vaccinated, and wear I.D. tags pursuant to Chapter 6.16.090. Dogs with spike collars are not allowed.
- No bicycles, rollerblades, roller skates, skateboards, strollers, and similar items except for wheelchairs and other aids for the disabled.
- Commercial or professional dog training or classes are not permitted.
