NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
SUMMARY OF A PROPOSED ORDINANCE XXX-2026 ADOPTING
REVISIONS TO TITLE 130 (ZONING ORDINANCE) OF EL DORADO
COUNTY REPEALING TOBACCO RETAILER LAND USE REGULATIONS

The Board of Supervisors (Board) will conduct a public hearing in 330 Fair Lane, Placerville, California, on **Tuesday, July 21, 2026, at 2:00 p.m.** to consider the Planning Commission recommendation to approve Ordinance XXX-2026 adopting revisions to Title 130 (Zoning Ordinance) of El Dorado County repealing Ordinance 5210. Specifically, the proposed ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days following adoption by the Board and would amend the Zoning Ordinance to 1) repeal Ordinance 5210, which established tobacco retailer land use regulations; 2) repeal Chapter 130.40.340 in its entirety; and 3) amend Section 130.22.020 and Table 130.22.020. The Board may take the following actions: 1) Find the repeal of Ordinance 5210 exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under section(s) 15060(c)(2) and 15378 of the CEQA Guidelines; and 2) Approve the repeal of Ordinance 5210 to amend Title 130 of the County Zoning Ordinance, repealing Chapter 130.40.340 in its entirety, and amending Table 130.22.020 to reflect this repeal. The Planning Commission has recommended approval of this Ordinance based on the Findings on file in Planning Services of the Planning and Building Department.
