NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC OF NONDISCRIMINATION IN PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES
UNDER TITLE VI

Public Notice of Non-Discrimination under Title VI of the Civil Rights
Act of 1964

El Dorado County DOT operates its programs and services without regard to race, color, or national origin. Anyone who believes they have been excluded from participation in, denied the benefits of, or otherwise subjected to discrimination under any El Dorado County DOT program or activity because of their race, color, or national origin may file a complaint. Federal and State law requires complaints to be filed within 180 calendar days of the alleged incident.
