This recommendation will be placed on the January 2021 Veteran Affairs Commission agenda.

The TOT Committee will request \$35,000 for the next round of mini grants. Kurt Raffetto commented that the TOT Committee is making a good faith effort to work with the county to reduce the 2021 grants. Roger Reynolds agreed that this year it was important to do so, however, this is a one-time only reduction and would like to have the regular TOT allocation next year.

Additional input is needed for the South Lake Tahoe area. Kurt requested Dan Browne join the committee to provide insight into the eligible agencies serving veterans in the South Lake Tahoe area. Dan agreed to join the committee.
