VIII. NEW BUSINESS

A. Raising of the Maximum Grantee Amount

Increasing the maximum mini grant amount from \$3,500 to \$5,000 was discussed. The committee would still have the option to award less than the maximum. The \$5,000 limit would only apply to mini-grants which are administered by the El Dorado Community Foundation. A motion was made by Roger Reynolds and seconded by Dan Browne to recommend this increase to the Veteran Affairs Commission. The motion was approved. The guidelines for mini-grant applications will need to be revised prior to the May meeting.

B. **\$9,000 Allotment from Mini-Grant Fund to Veterans Memorial Building for Storage** After discussion, it was decided that more research will be needed to determine who will be responsible for building the storage shed, what funds will be used to pay for the storage shed, and will the shed have security.
