VFW Historic Preservation, Memorial Walk

Grant Request SUMMARY: In 300 words or less please provide a summary that describes the program/project that your organization is requesting funds for.

The VFW was established on April 12, 1947 after WWII veterans returned to the Divide. The main VFW Hall and Canteen are located on Main Street in historic Georgetown, CA. The VFW is working with several local programs including the VFW Auxiliary, Mental Health on the Divide, the Georgetown Divide Rotary Club, KFOK Radio, The Georgetown Preservation Society, and the Native Sons of the Golden West to elevate the historic contributions of the VFW Hall. The entryway of the VFW Hall is intended to serve as a historic walk and memorial to Veterans, a Memorial Walk. The VFW Park houses a small connex box filled with historic items to be placed along the entry wall including original uniforms from local veterans who served in each of the major combat conflicts. The VFW Post members and the veteran community would like to create a series of large scale shadow boxes which are traditionally used to display memorabilia. The boxes would be used to house and preserve military resources that help tell the story of important military operations and the contributions of our veterans. This serves two functions: it helps install a sense of pride and informs the community about the contributions of service members in their community.

The Growlersburg Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) building holds significant historic value as a physical representation of veterans and an honor to their service and commitment to the United States of America. The VFW is on Main Street in Georgetown in a historic building. The Hall is a community hub where VFW members continue their commitment to service and support a variety of community projects annually: Monthly food bank, Holiday dinners, Santa Program including stuffing over 200 stockings that are delivered annually to low income children, music program, youth development including movie nights and collaborate with our organizations to celebrate the historic value of Georgetown.

Sadly, the VFW Hall currently has no memorabilia displays on the wall to commemorate or to inform the community of the many and varied contributions of veterans. This project will help elevate the pride of our veterans and instill in our community a collective conscience of our veteran contributions. Members of KFOK Radio and the Georgetown Preservation Society have committed to creating an audio history to accompany each shadow box. The project will also serve as a historic landmark to encourage tourists to visit Georgetown for its historic value.

The VFW Post meeting Hall has no historic memorabilia. Georgetown is a historic town. There are over 400 square feet of space available to house shadow boxes to make the VFW a local destination with historic value. The is a connex box filled with donated memorabilia from local families currently not displayed. A key mission of the VFW is to install a sense of pride and communion amongst veterans and within the community.

How will this program/project in this grant request address the need described above?

This grant will enable the VFW and a broad array of community members to build a Memorial Walkway in the VFW Hall. The VFW was established in 1947 in part to honor local veterans and preserve their legacy. Plans for a Memorial Walk at the hall's entryway include displays of historic uniforms and memorabilia in large shadow boxes, showcasing the stories of local veterans and those who served in each of the major conflicts. This effort aims to instill pride and educate the community on the lasting contributions of those who served.

There is a committed group of VFW Post members who have identified this a critical project and have formed a Historic Preservation Committee. The Georgetown Preservation Society has identified the value and need for this project and have volunteered support. The VFW Auxiliary has committed support and has dedicated volunteers to support this project. Members of the Chamber of Commerce have expressed their full commitment and have volunteered to support this project. Rotary members have volunteered to support this project. KFOK Radio members have volunteered to support this project.

The Georgetown VFW Post stands as a symbol of patriotism, brotherhood, and historical preservation. Located in historic Georgetown, CA, the Post actively partners with local organizations—including the VFW Auxiliary, Georgetown Divide Rotary Club, KFOK Radio, and the Georgetown Preservation Society—to honor the service and sacrifice of veterans.

Aligned with the VFW's mission to perpetuate the memory of the fallen and those who have served, foster true patriotism, and educate the public, the Post is developing a Memorial Walk at its Hall entrance. This historic pathway will feature military artifacts, including original uniforms from local veterans, and large shadow boxes showcasing significant military contributions. Through these displays, the VFW seeks to preserve history, inspire community pride, and educate future generations about the enduring values of service, sacrifice, and American freedom.

This initiative is part of a broader effort to honor veterans, educate the public, and build a stronger sense of community. In partnership with local organizations—including the VFW Auxiliary, Georgetown Divide Rotary Club, KFOK Radio, and the Georgetown Preservation Society—the Post will curate historic military artifacts, including original uniforms and large shadow boxes that tell the stories of local veterans and major military events.

Upon completion, this project is expected to produce measurable and lasting benefits for both veterans and the broader community:

VFW members will see their service and the legacy of their comrades preserved with honor, improving morale and strengthening fraternal bonds. This will be measured through member feedback and post-project surveys.

The displays will provide a powerful educational experience, deepening the community's understanding of the sacrifices made by veterans and the importance of military service. Community surveys will assess the increase in awareness and appreciation

By transforming the Hall into a space of public education and remembrance, the project will draw more visitors, including students, families, and local patrons. Participation numbers and event attendance will be tracked to measure increased engagement. This Memorial Walk is more than a physical project—it is a tribute to the past, a source of pride in the present,
