

EL DORADO COUNTY VETERANS MONUMENT APPLICATION FOR MILITARY HONORARIA

The El Dorado County Veterans Monument honors the in-service accomplishments of military veterans. Veterans of the United States Armed Forces or American Forces constituted prior to the American Revolution may be memorialized at the El Dorado County Veterans Monument. Memorialized veterans must be a resident or former resident of El Dorado County or be a friend or family member of a current or former El Dorado County resident. Veterans who were dishonorably discharged from the military are not eligible to be memorialized at the monument.

Applications for military honoraria should be submitted to the El Dorado County Veteran Services Office, 130 Placerville Drive, Placerville, CA. Applications may also be emailed to EDCVeteransMonument@edcgov.us.

All applications for honoraria will be reviewed by the El Dorado County Veterans Service Officer (VSO) to confirm eligibility. Approved applications will be forwarded to the El Dorado County Veterans Alliance for payment of honoraria and coordination for placement at the Veterans Monument. Proceeds from the sale of honoraria benefit the El Dorado County Veterans Coalition, a 501(c)(3) organization that provides scholarships for El Dorado County veterans and their families.

Types of Honoraria

Engraved memorial bricks and stones are the most common items to be placed at the Monument. Memorial bricks honor individual veterans, are 8X4 inches, and contain three lines of type, with a maximum of 14 characters per line including spaces. Memorial stones honor an individual veteran or Unit of the U.S. Armed Forces, are 8X8 inches and contain up to five lines and a maximum of 14 characters per line including spaces.

Note: There is very limited space at the Monument for engraved benches or for plaques on the Honor Wall. If requesting either of these items, in addition to this application please send an email specifying the type of honoraria requested to the Veteran Services Office at: EDCVeteransMonument@edcgov.us.

Stones only: add two lines

First Line

First and Last Name. Middle name may be included. Initials may be used in place of first and last name. Suffixes may be included following last name (e.g. J. R. Smith Jr.).

Second Line

Military Rank and Branch of Service.

Third Line

Awards and/or Wars. Wars may be spelled out. Years of service may be added to second or third line, space permitting.

Add two lines for stones.**COST**

***Please note, payment will be made to The Veterans Alliance prior to installation. EDC Veteran Services Office does not accept payment for military honoraria.** Price includes proof, engraving, installation and a donation to benefit scholarships for veterans and their families. Location of bricks is random and cannot be specified. With advance notice, multiple memorials, submitted at the same time, can be installed near one another (staple forms together).

Memorial Bricks (8" x 4") - \$150 Memorial Stones (8" x 8") – \$500

Acknowledgements: I attest that the veteran's information provided on this application is true and accurate to the best of my knowledge. I accept that memorial applications that contain false or exaggerated service information will be denied. I understand that if my application is approved by the El Dorado County Veterans Service Officer, the El Dorado Veterans Alliance will email or provide me with a proof of the requested brick/memorial information before it is engraved and I agree that the memorial will not be made until after I have returned a signed proof attesting that the information is accurate and spelled correctly. I will also provide payment to the El Dorado Veterans Alliance for the requested honoraria. I accept that the El Dorado County Veterans Alliance is not obligated to correct errors on proof-approved finished memorials and agree to purchase an entirely new memorial should I want errors on a proof-approved finished memorial corrected. By signing this, I also attest that I am a current or former resident of El Dorado County, and that I am related to or have an established friendship with the veteran to be honored.
